Facts about plastic: In the UK we throw away around 455,000 tonnes of plastic bottles every year – equivalent to around 9.1 billion bottles. It takes just 25 two-litre plastic bottles to make a recycled fleece jacket. Recycling just one plastic bottle saves enough energy to power a 60W lightbulb for six hours. Around 11% of our household waste is plastic and 40% of this is plastic bottles.
