Hillingdon Council is the first council in the UK to partner with Simply Cups, a service dedicated to recycling paper and plastic cups and turning them into second-life materials.

The bins are located at the council's main Civic Centre in Uxbridge and at a number of libraries across Hillingdon as well as at the Battle of Britain Bunker Exhibition and Visitor Centre.

Residents can pop into any of the venues to recycle takeaway cups, and each bin is dedicated to separating the lids, cups and liquids to allow them to be recycled efficiently.

Our nearest Coffee cup recycling bins can be found at Uxbridge library and the Civic Centre.
